Extraction of Coal Bed Methane

- (a) the current status of extraction of coal bed methane in various coal mines located in the country and the challenges being faced by the Government for its extraction; and
- (b) the steps taken or proposed to be taken by the Government to deal with the said challenges?

(a) & (b): At present, Coal Bed Methane (CBM) is not produced from any working/operational coal mines in the country. Government of India had formulated a policy in 1997 to extract Coal Bed Methane (CBM) from coal-bearing areas prior to the mining of coal and a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was also signed between the Ministry of Coal and the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, to act in a cooperative manner for the development of CBM.
