- (c) whether the Government intends to handhold the youth of Punjab and grant industry Tax Holiday Benefit Status as was given to Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Jammu & Kashmir, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to give the special status for setting up industries along the border belt within 50 kms of the border;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?
