- (a) whether the Government has failed to boost export of organic tea from the country though there is huge potential in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the total quantity of organic tea exported during each of the last three years and the current year and the foreign exchange earned;
- (d) whether export of organic tea has been affected after COVID-19 pandemic and if so, the corrective steps taken to promote export of organic tea;
- (e) whether the Government has taken any steps for expanding the cultivable area of organic tea and if so, the details thereof:
- (f) whether the Tea Board has taken any action for promotion of organic tea farming in Assam by facilitating certification; and
- (g) if so, the number of licenses issued to the tea farmers/tea gardens of Assam and the funds allocated for promotion of organic tea farming during the last three years, State-wise?

(a) to (d): No, Sir. The export of organic tea in value terms has increased from 49.71 Million USD in 2019-20 to 54.54 Million USD in 2021-22. In order to promote export of organic tea, the Tea

Board undertakes promotional initiatives such as participation in international trade fairs dedicated to organic products and organising buyer-seller meets.

The details of organic tea exported during the last three years, which include the period of COVID-19 pandemic, and the current year is given in the following table:

(e) to (g): The Government has accorded due priority to the promotion and development of organic tea farming in the country including Assam. The Government of India, through the Tea Board, inter alia, provides financial assistance for conversion from conventional to organic cultivation, organic farm inputs, and for organic certification to plantation & manufacturing units under the Tea Development & Promotion Scheme.

The financial assistance extended for promotion of organic tea farming during the last three years and current financial year 2022-23 (till February 2023), State-wise is given below:
