- (a) whether the Ghar Tak Fibre Yojana is still ongoing and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of benefits being acquired from this scheme;
- (c) the details of total number of villages which have been connected with fibre till date, pan India; and
- (d) the details of villages in Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Odisha connected with fibre including Pali in Rajasthan, Gonda-Bahraich, Jhansi, Deoria districts of Uttar Pradesh and Balasore district of Odisha?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

- (a): There is no such Program under Government of India for Ghar Tak Fibre Yojana.
- (b): However, the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) / Bharat Broadband Nigam Limited (BBNL), Government of India is implementing the BharatNet project in a phased manner. The BharatNet project will connect Gram Panchayats (GPs) / Villages with broadband in the country. This infrastructure may be leased to Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) / Internet Service Providers (ISPs) for provision of internet connectivity in GPs / rural areas, including villages / Government institutions, schools and private areas.

The BharatNet network has been utilized for providing broadband connectivity in rural areas. As of February 2023, the status of utilization is as under:

No. of Fibre to the Home (FTTH) connections commissioned: 2,53,160

No. of Wi-Fi Hotspots installed at GPs: 1,04,671

Dark Fibre leased: 59,831 Km Leased Bandwidth: 2,14,814 Mbps

- (c): The number of Gram Panchayats (GPs) which have been connected on fibre under the BharatNet project as of February 2023 is 1,84,554.
- (d): The details of GPs made service ready as of February 2023 are given below:
