**GOVERNMENT JOBS TO YOUTH**

†3612. **SHRI KAUSHALENDRA KUMAR:**

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of youths who have been given Government jobs in various Government departments during the last five years;
- (b) whether the number of educated unemployed is continuously increasing due to non-recruitment in regular Government jobs;
- (c) whether lakhs of applications are being received for a small number of posts or vacancies and the number of applicants with much higher qualifications than the standard qualifications are very large;
- (d) whether most of the appointments are challenged in the court and get stuck in the courts for years which also hinders appointments on time; and
- (e) the number of educated unemployed in the country, State-wise and Trade-wise?
