† 3646. SHRIMATI REKHA VERMA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the trains (i) 04559-04560, (ii) 15273-15274, (iii) 05161-05162, (iv) 05655- 05656, (v) 05621-05622 had stoppages at Maholi railway station which were discontinued during Corona period;

(b) if so, the time by which the stoppages of these trains is likely to be resumed at Maholi railway station; and

(c) the efforts made by the Government for the stoppage of these trains at Maholi?

(a) and (b) No, Sir. None of the mentioned trains, prior to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, had scheduled stoppage at Maholi station.
