- (b) the number of Government and private psychiatrists, mental health counsellors and workers available in Jharkhand, district-wise;
- (c) the number of people who have sought treatment for mental health issues since 2019-20, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) the number of people who have sought treatment for mental health issues since 2019-20 in Jharkhand, district-wise?

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) & (b) The data regarding number of Government and private psychiatrists and mental health counsellors and workers available, State/UT-wise, is not maintained centrally. The mental health services are available at three Central Mental Health Institutions, viz. National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences (NIMHANS), Bengaluru, Central Institute of Psychiatry (CIP), Ranchi, Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health (LGBRIMH), Tezpur, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) and Medical Colleges. Mental Health services are provided at district level through District Mental Health Programme (DMHP).

Further, as per the information received from State Government of Jharkhand, the details of Government and private psychiatrists, mental health counsellors and workers available in Jharkhand, district-wise, is at Annexure-I.

(c) & (d) The data regarding number of people who have sought treatment for mental health issues since 2019-20, State/UT-wise, is not maintained centrally. However, number of people seeking treatment for mental health issues in three Central Mental Health Institutions, viz. National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences (NIMHANS), Bengaluru, Central Institute of Psychiatry (CIP), Ranchi and Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi Regional Institute of Mental Health (LGBRIMH), Tezpur since 2019-20 is as under:
