- (a) whether the Government proposes to introduce a Vande Bharat Train for the tourists and traders visiting Kathgodam and Udham Singh Nagar from Delhi ;**
- (b) if so, the time by which the train is likely to be made operational;**
- (c) whether there is a proposal to introduce any special train from Delhi to religious places of the Sikhs in the country; and**
- (d) if so, the time by which it is likely to be introduced and the amenities to be provided therein?**
