(a) the details of the funds released to Kerala including Kottayam under various schemes of the Ministry of Science and Technology;

(b) whether the funds released under the said scheme have already been utilised in the conceived schemes; and

(c) if so, the details of such schemes under which the work has been completed or is on the verge of completion?

(a) The Ministry of Science and Technology (MoST), Government of India (Gol) is implementing several schemes for the promotion of Science and Technology (S&T) in the country including the State of Kerala through three main wings of the Ministry namely the Department of Science and Technology (DST), the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) and the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR)/ Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR). The schemes and programmes of the Ministry are in alignment with different components of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and National Development Programmes (NDPs) catering to different cross-sections of society and nurturing the Science, Technology and Innovation (STI) ecosystem through support towards

- i. Research & Development
- ii. S&T Institutional and Human Capacity Building,
- iii. Innovation, Technology Development and Deployment for socioeconomic development

Suitable technologies for rejuvenating aged coffee plants were introduced in Kottayam for the socio-economic benefit of coffee farmers. St. George's College, Kottayam and M. G. University, Kottayam, have been supported under Fund for Improvement of S&T (FIST) infrastructure in Universities and higher educational institutions and Sophisticated Analytical Instrument Facilities (SAIF)/Promotion of University Research and Scientific Excellence (PURSE) schemes of DST respectively.
