FUNDS SPENT UNDER AMRUT SCHEME

NO. 3709. SHRI DILESHWAR KAMAIT: SHRI SUNIL BABURAO MENDHE:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds spent in the first phase ofAtal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) scheme in Bihar and Bhandara Gondiya districts of Maharashtra; and
- (b) the names of the districts in Bihar and Maharashtra where the said scheme is proposed to be implemented?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a): For the State of Bihar, State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) amounting to ₹2,469.77 crore, including committed Central Assistance of ₹1,164.80 was approved during the first phase of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT). Central Assistance of ₹1,055.87 crore has been released to the State Government for implementation of projects approved under the scheme. So far, 64 projects worth ₹2,455.16 crore have been grounded and overall expenditure of ₹1,697.03 crore has been incurred by the State Government on these projects.

Gondiya city in Bhandara –Gondiya districts of Maharashtra was selected in the first phase of AMRUT scheme, under which, city has grounded 4 projects worth ₹135.53 crore. Expenditure of ₹49.17 crore has been incurred so far on these projects.

(b): 27 cities from 22 districts of Biharand 44 cities from 28 districts of Maharashtra were covered in the first phase of AMRUT scheme. Names of these districts along with details of AMRUT cities located in them is placed at ANNEXURE.
