- (a) whether Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) play an important role in manufacturing sector of the country;
- (b) if so, the percentage contribution of MSMEs in total production of manufacturing sector during the last four years and the current year in Karnataka;
- (c) whether some units of MSMEs have also been closed during the said period in Karnataka; and
- (d) if so, the number of closed units during each year of the said period and the reasons therefor?

(a) to (b): Yes, the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) play an important role in manufacturing sector of the country. As per the latest information received from Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, the share of manufacturing MSME Gross Value Output (GVO) in All India Manufacturing Gross Value Output (GVO) (in %) was as follows:
