WORKING OF BIO-GAS PLANTS

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has set up any mechanism to ascertain that the installed bio-gas plants are working smoothly; and
- (b) the details of the bio-gas plants installed in Madhya Pradesh so far, district-wise?

 ANSWER

- (a) Under the Biogas Programme of the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, 5 years warranty for the biogas plants has to be provided by the turnkey workers (TKW)/ Biogas plant installer, which includes Operation and Maintenance Services of the biogas plants for desired operations. Any complaints lodged by the biogas user are to be attended by the TKW/ installer within a time period of one week. The Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for the installed biogas plants is released only after 100 % verification by officials of the Biogas Programme Implementation Agency. The Biogas Development and Training Centers (BDTC) setup under the Programme conduct user's training programmes at village level for creating awareness, effective use of biogas, smooth and trouble-free operations by the biogas users.
- (b) The district wise details of the small bio-gas plants installed in Madhya Pradesh are given at **Annexure-I.**
