ALLOCATION OF FUNDS UNDER PM-KUSUM

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) the quantum of the funds allocated, released and spent under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM) scheme since its launch;

(b) the number of beneficiaries under PM-KUSUM scheme, State/UT-wise;

(c) whether the Government proposes to achieve the target of solarisation of 1.5 million grid-connected solar-powered agriculture pumps, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) whether the Government also proposes to achieve the target of installation of 2 million standalone solar-powered agriculture pumps, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND POWER

(a) & (b) PM-KUSUM is a demand driven scheme and therefore quantities/ capacities are allocated under the three components of the scheme based on demand received from the States/UTs. However, funds are allocated based on type/ capacity of systems and progress of installation reported by the State Implementing Agencies. So far, a total amount of Rs. 1369 Crore has been released and an amount of Rs. 1217 Crore has been spent by the State Implementing Agencies under the Scheme.

State/UT-wise details of the farmers benefitted under the Scheme are given in Annexure.

(c)&(d) Government has allowed inter-se transfer of quantities between Component-B for installation of standalone solar pumps and Component-C for solarization of existing grid-connected agricultural pumps, including through feeder level solarization. Therefore, a combined target of 3.5 million pumps has been kept under these two components of the Scheme. Entire targeted quantity of 3.5 million pumps has been allocated to various States/UTs. Out of this, over 2.08 lakh pumps have been reported as installed/ solarized as on 28.02.2023.
