3748. COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to promote the MSME industries in Rajasthan during the last five years;
- (b) the current status of projects being incubated under 'A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industries and Entrepreneurship' (ASPIRE) in Rajasthan;
- (c) the number of beneficiaries under the said scheme, State-wise including Rajasthan;
- (d) the details of the Technology Business Incubators and Livelihood Business Incubators set up and functional under ASPIRE scheme for entrepreneurship and to promote innovation in rural industry, State and year-wise; and
- (e) the list of incubation centres in Rajasthan along with their achievements, scheme-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES
(SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

(a): A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industries and Entrepreneurship' (ASPIRE) aims to impart various skill development and incubation programs to the rural youth, women and the unemployed to enable them set up their own enterprises or get suitably employed in the nearby industrial cluster. The Livelihood Business Incubators (LBI) component of the scheme continues whereas, the Technology Business Incubator (TBI) component of the scheme has been discontinued due convergence with Incubation Scheme of the Office of Development Commissioner, Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises.

(b): A total of 14 business incubators (LBI-10 and TBI-4) have been approved in the State of Rajasthan, out of which 2 LBIs and 2 TBIs are functional, 1 TBI has withdrawn from the scheme and the rest are under various stages of implementation.

(c): A list of State-wise number of beneficiaries, including State of Rajasthan, is placed at **Annexure-I**.

(d): A total of 102 Livelihood Business Incubators (LBIs) and 22 Technology Business Incubators (TBIs) have been approved under ASPIRE till date, out of which 71 LBIs and 14 TBIs have become functional. A list of approved and functional LBIs and TBIs is placed at **Annexure-II**.

(e): In the State of Rajasthan, a total 1071 beneficiaries have been trained in the 2 functional LBIs, of which 170 beneficiaries have been employed in nearby industries and 42 beneficiaries have become self-employed. List of LBIs and TBIs approved in the State of Rajasthan is placed as **Annexure-III**. Further, 6 startups are being incubated in the 2 functional TBIs in the State of Rajasthan, the details of which are annexed as **Annexure-IV**.
