- (a) the salient features of Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 2.0 (SBM-U 2.0);**
- (b) the details of funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under this Mission during the last three years and current year in Rajasthan;**
- (c) the details of targets set and achieved so far under this Mission In Rajasthan;**
- (d) whether the Government has launched Swachh Sarvekshan – 2023 in the country under SBM-U 2.0;**
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (f) whether the Government has made any amendment under this Mission and if so, the details thereof?**

(a) : SBM – Urban 2.0 was launched on 1st October, 2021 with the vision to achieve “Garbage Free” status through 100% source segregation, door-to-door collection and scientific processing of all fraction of waste, safe disposal in scientific landfill, remediation of all legacy dumpsites by converting into green zones and treatment of used water including faecal sludge for Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) under 1 lakh population to ensure that no untreated water pollutes the ground water or water bodies.

(b) : The details of funds allocated to and claims by the State of Rajasthan under SBM-U 2.0, since its launch is given under. The utilization will become due after lapse of one year.

(c) : SBM-U was launched during October, 2014 with the objectives of making entire urban areas of the country Open Defecation Free (ODF) and for scientific management of the entire Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) generated. In order to carry forward the progress made under SBM-U, the next phase i.e. SBM-U 2.0 has been launched. The details of cumulative progress made so far under the mission since 2014 in Rajasthan as reported on Swachhatam portal is as under:

(d) & (e) : On the 24th May 2022, Swachh Survekshan (SS) 2023 was launched with the theme of 'Waste to Wealth'. The survey would give priority to the principle of 3Rs – Reduce, Recycle and Reuse. The theme of SS 2023 is aligned to SBMU 2.0's commitment of promoting circularity in waste management, which is one of key objectives under the Mission. In SS 2023, additional weightage has been given to source segregation of waste, enhancement of waste processing capacity of cities to match the waste generation and reduction of waste going to the dumpsites.

(f) : No amendment has been made under SBM-U 2.0.
