- (a) the steps being taken by the Government to address the issue of inadequate factory accommodation for the MSMEs in Delhi;
- (b) the steps being taken by the Government to optimize and increase the exports in the two unidentified manufacturing clusters of Pottery and Printing & Packaging in Delhi; and
- (c) the total number of MSMEs which have utilized the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme in Delhi during the last two years?

- (a) & (b): As reported by the Government of Delhi, to address the issue of inadequate factory accommodation for the MSMEs in Delhi, Delhi State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation (DSIIDC) is taking up redevelopment of Flatted Factory Complex at Jhandewalan & proposed Industrial areas at Ranikhera & Baprola. Further, District Export Action Plan of North West District Delhi is under process wherein clay products are identified for export under One District One Product (ODOP) scheme.
- (c): The total number of MSMEs which have utilized the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme in Delhi during the financial year FY 2021-22 & FY 2022-23 (as on 31.01.2023) are 13874 & 915 respectively.
