Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the villages identified for the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in West Bengal, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Jammu and Kashmir and particularly Sonapat district of Haryana respectively during the last four years, year and district-wise;
- (b) the criteria being considered for inclusion of villages in each phase of implementation of JJM;
- (c) the progress made in the implementation of waste water management in the aforesaid States along with the financial outlay made thereon, year and district-wise; and
- (d) the details of utilisation of funds allocated to aforesaid States, district-wise?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI
(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)**

(a) & (b) To enable every rural household in the country, including those in the villages of West Bengal, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Jammu and Kashmir and Sonapat district of Haryana, to have provision of tap water supply, Government of India in partnership with States is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal, since August 2019.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, 3.23 Crore (17%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. So far, as reported by States/ UTs as on 20.03.2023, additional 8.26 Crore rural households have been provided with tap water connections in last three and half years under JJM. Thus, as on 20.03.2023, out of 19.43 Crore rural households in the country, around 11.49 Crore (59%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes.

(c) Grey water management is one of the focus areas under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) [SBM (G)] and as reported, the details of villages covered with Grey Water Management (GWM) in the States of West Bengal, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Jammu & Kashmir and Haryana, are as under: -

(d) Under SBM(G), funds are released directly to the States/ UTs and their further distribution to the Districts/ Blocks/ Gram Panchayats level is done by the respective State/ UT. Details of Central grants-in aid released to and utilization reported by the States of West Bengal, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Jammu and Kashmir and Haryana under SBM (G) during the last four years are as under:
