PROJECTS DEVELOPED UNDER TOT MODE

3814. SHRI DULAL CHANDRA GOSWAMI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government had invited bids for the development of National Highway projects under Toll Operate and Transfer (TOT) mode and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the projects completed under TOT mode during the last three years and the current year;
- (c) the profits earned and the achievements made under TOT mode;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to launch second phase under TOT mode in near future and if so, the details thereof along with the projects identified for the purpose; and
- (e) the profits likely to be earned as a result thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) Yes Sir. The details of bids invited under TOT Bundles for Asset Monetisation are placed at Annexure.

- (b) to (c) Till date, 22 stretches (1,614 km) have been monetised through TOT mode in six Bundles (1, 3, 5A1, 5A2, 7 & 9), for Rs. 26,365 crore, out of which Rs.3,144 crore (TOT-9), is likely to be realized by March, 2023. The concession value of the various TOT bundles monetised during the last three years and the current year is placed at Annexure.
- (d) to (e) NHAI has already invited Bids for two more TOT Bundles, Bundle 11 (Allahabad Bypass Project-84.708 Km) and Bundle 12 (Lalitpur-Lakhnadon -316.084 km) in January 2023 [Bid due date: 10.03.2023, which is now extended to 27.03.2023].

In addition, 30 stretches of length 1,987 km have been identified for monetisation during FY24 on TOT/InvIT/Securitisation mode. A list of these 30 stretches has been published on NHAI website so as to enable the investors to carry out their due diligence. The priority and mode of monetization shall be decided on the basis of project viability and market appetite.

Budgetary target of Rs. 10,000 crore has been envisaged for FY24 for Asset Monetisation of Road Sector under Toll Operate and Transfer (TOT) mode.
