**3832. SHRI SUNIL BABURAO MENDHE:**

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of families who have got benefit of tap connections under Har Ghar Nal Se Jal Yojana in the State of Maharashtra;
- (b) the number of connections sanctioned in Maharashtra under the yojana; and
- (c) the number of beneficiaries under the yojana in Maharashtra, District-wise?

**ANSWER**

(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (c) Government of India, in partnership with States/UTs including Maharashtra is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), since August 2019, to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household in the country.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in Maharashtra, 48.44 lakh (33.01%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, tap water connections have been provided to additional 60.09 lakh rural households. As on 20.03.2023, out of total 146.73 lakh rural households in Maharashtra, provision of tap water supply has been made to 108.53 lakh (73.97%) households.
