(a) whether it is a fact that the Government proposes to shut down 116 road infrastructure projects worth Rs. 1.26 lakh crore;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the date of sanction, targeted date of completion, the estimated cost of the projects, total expenditure already incurred, State/UT-wise and project-wise;

(c) the reasons for shutting down the projects, project-wise;

(d) whether the said projects are likely to be replaced with new projects; and

(e) if so, the details of the new projects along with the estimated cost of the new projects, State/ UT and project-wise?
