- (a) whether the Government has started projects of laying Optical Fibre Cables (OFC) along National Highways (NHs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of NHs identified for the purpose, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has undertaken the said project in Odisha; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Yes, Madam. Two pilot projects of laying Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) along Delhi - Mumbai Expressway NE-4 in 1368 Km length in the States of Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat & Maharashtra and along Hyderabad -Bangalore Highway NH-44 in 512 Km length in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Telangana & Karnataka, totaling to 1880 Kms have been taken up. Based on the experience and learning of these two-pilot projects and outcome of feasibility studies, a program of OFC laying for network of National Highway (Greenfield and Brownfield) in the Country would be framed.
