Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of ex-servicemen in the country, State/UT-wise including Srikakulam parliamentary constituency;
- (b) the number of Ex-servicemen who have been re-employed in other Government jobs;
- (c) whether the Government will consider floating a specialized portal for Ex-servicemen and prospective employers to streamline the re-employment of Ex-servicemen; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): Details of State/UT-wise registered Ex-Servicemen in the country is annexed as Annexure. The number of registered Ex-Servicemen of Srikakulam Parliamentary Constituency is 6183.
- (b): (i) The reservation policy for ESM is being implemented through Cadre Controlling Ministries/Departments/Public Sector Undertakings. Based on the information received from 123 Cadre Controlling Ministries/Department/Public Sector Undertaking/Public Sectors Banks and Central Armed Police Forces, there were 44,904Ex-Servicemen on the strength of these organisations.
- (ii) Details of Ex-Servicemen re-employed in Defence Security Corps (DSC) are as under: -
