ANSWER

(a) to (c): As per the policy, when a service for convenience of passengers is closed abruptly by the service provider/operator, remedial action is initiated by the Airports Authority of India (AAI) to resume the service by inviting open tenders.

The placement of essential facilities such as Food and Beverages (F& B) is processed under contingency service with at least bare minimum outlets, for convenience of passengers on abrupt closure by the service provider.

Currently, there are five F&B licensed facilities (one with bar facility) available covering all locations of inside / outside of Terminal Building at Amritsar Airport. Additionally, Executive Lounge facility is also operational in Domestic terminal at Amritsar Airport.
