#### **PROJECTS UNDER SCM**

#### NO. 3906. DR. KALANIDHI VEERASWAMY:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has realised wider limitations and gaps in its method of making inclusive cities;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of projects that were allocated and implemented in North Chennai Constituency under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM); and
- (d) the details of funds allocated to the said Constituency in specific for the projects under SCM?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

- (a) & (b): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. The objectives of SCM, inter alia, are to promote cities that provide core infrastructure and give decent quality of life to their citizens, clean and sustainable environment through the application of smart solutions. The focus is on sustainable and inclusive development and the idea is to look at compact areas, create replicable models which will act like lighthouses to other aspiring cities.
- (c) & (d): The city of Chennai in Tamil Nadu was selected for development as a Smart City in the Round-1 of the selection process in January 2016. As on 3 March 2023, Government of India has released ₹ 490 crore for the Chennai Smart City and the State Government of Tamil Nadu has released its matching share of ₹ 500 crore amounting to a total release of ₹ 990 crore, of which ₹ 890 crore (90%) has been utilized. As on 3 March 2023, of 48 projects undertaken by Chennai Smart City, 43 projects (90%) have been completed. The details of the projects being implemented by Chennai Smart City in North Chennai Constituency is given in Annexure-I.
