Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made any assessment to find out the number of deaths caused due to communicable diseases accounted since 2020 in the country in comparison to the other factors/causes;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard, State/UT-wise particularly in Odisha and Maharashtra;
- (c) whether inspite of these numbers, the funds allocated to the NDCP flexi pool over the years are in small proportion to the other sections of the NHM;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether the Government has any plans to identify the bottlenecks and patterns of communicable diseases in India and take appropriate measures accordingly; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (f):

With an aim to strengthen disease surveillance in the country, Union Health Ministry has launched Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme in 2004 to detect and respond to epidemic–prone diseases.

As reported by State/UTs details of deaths due to communicable disease and other factors in India including States of Odisha and Maharashtra is placed at Annexure I, Covid 19 deaths at Annexure II, H1N1 at Annexure III and TB at Annexure IV.

Under National Health Mission (NHM) funds are released to States/UTs under flexible pools on a lump sum basis to provide greater flexibility to States/UTs to utilize the funds as per their felt need and priorities. Financial support is provided to the States/UTs for implementation of these programmes, on the basis of their proposals in Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs).

Health is a state subject. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare provides technical and financial supports to States/UTs through various schemes including National Vector Borne Diseases Control Programme (NVBDCP), National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP), National Leprosy Eradication Programme (NLEP) and National Viral Hepatitis Control Programme (NVHCP) under the aegis of National Health Mission (NHM) to prevent and control various communicable diseases.
