Will the **MINISTER of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the allocation and utilisation of funds under the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram since 2019, State/UT-wise including Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the achievements made so far since its inception;
- (d) whether the Government has made any assessment of the said Scheme through social audit and if so, the details and the outcome thereof;
- (e) the number of children covered since the inception of the said scheme, State/UT-wise; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes to set up high-level laboratories in the hospitals/Health Centres for early detection of genetic disorders and other diseases along with vaccination to the affected children and if so, the details thereof along with the amount allocated for the said purpose?

(a) to (f)

Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) programme under Reproductive, Maternal, Newborn, Child, Adolescent health and Nutrition (RMNCAH+N) strategy, of National Health Mission, Government of India, provides screening services for selected health conditions to children through dedicated mobile health teams placed in every block. Children from birth to six years of age are screened at Anganwadi centres twice a year and children from 6 years till 18 years of age enrolled in Government and Government aided schools in classes 1st to 12th are screened once a year.

Government of India is supporting all States/UTs in implementation of RBSK under, National Health Mission, based on the Annual Program Implementation Plan (APIP) submitted by States/ UTs.

State/UT-wise approvals and utilisation for Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram under NHM in last three years as per Financial Management Report (FMR) is given at Annexure 1.

As reported by States/UTs, 129.45 crore children have been covered under RBSK during multiple visits since inception in FY 2014-15 till FY 2021-22, is given at Annexure 2.

RBSK is monitored under National Health Mission through regular review of quarterly reports, annual reviews during the appraisals process of Programme Implementation Plans, field visits and meetings with State nodal officers and through Common Review Missions.

The Department of Biotechnology started the Unique Methods of Management of Inherited Disorders (UMMID) Initiative in 2019, which has three components. Under the first component, 5 NIDAN Kendras (genetic testing laboratories) have been established at Government hospitals. Under the second component (outreach), prenatal and newborn screening is carried out at District Hospitals at 9 Aspirational Districts, coordinated by 7 premier research institutes of India. Under the third component, 6 training centers have been established for training of in-service Government doctors in genetic diagnostics and counseling. The total amount allocated for the above is Rs. 36.43 Crores. More than 50,000 children have been screened so far for 5 treatable inherited metabolic disorders. The UMMID Initiative is expanded to establish 20 more NIDAN Kendras at Government Hospitals, and bring 21 more Aspirational Districts under the outreach component.
