- (a) whether the Mumbai Port Trust has decided to develop a vision for the future development of the Eastern Water Front and Western Water Front in the Mumbai Port Trust;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has identified infrastructure requirements of the plan in Mumbai Port Trust; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?.

(a)&(b) Yes, Sir. Mumbai Port Authority has decided to develop a vision for the future development only for eastern waterfront of Mumbai for the land belonging to Mumbai Port. Proposal for development along the eastern waterfront of Mumbai is submitted to State Government of Maharashtra under Maharashtra Regional and Town Planning Act, 1966.

(c)&(d) Yes, Sir. The approximate requirement for development of infrastructure is as under:-

i) Water supply	-	69 Million Litre Per Day (MLD)
ii) Sewerage	-	55 Million Litre Per Day (MLD)
iii) Power supply	-	2222 Mega Watt (MW)
iv) Solid Waste Management	-	148 Metric Tons Per Day (TPD)
