#### 3999: SHRI JAYANT SINHA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the implementation of the Universal Immunisation Programme (UIP) was affected during the course of COVID-19 pandemic;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the measures taken/being taken by the Government to ensure the immunisation of those children who missed their dosage; and
- (d) the percentage of children between the age of 12-23 months immunised under UIP during the year 2021-22, vaccination-wise, State/UT-wise including district-wise in Jharkhand?

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE

### (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) to (c) Guidelines were issued to all States/UTs to ensure that Routine Immunization services under Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) are delivered during the COVID-19 pandemic while following COVID appropriate behavior. However, there were some eligible children who were left out or dropped out for the due vaccine doses from Routine Immunization. Two rounds of Mission Indradhanush were conducted in the year 2021 and 2022 during the COVID 19 pandemic to vaccinate the left out and dropped out children and pregnant women with the missed vaccine doses.
  - (d) All the primary vaccine doses are administered within one year of age and only booster doses are administered at the age of 12-23 months under UIP. Percentage of children between the age of 12-23 months immunized under UIP during the year 2021-22, vaccination-wise, State/UT-wise and district-wise in Jharkhand is placed at Annexure 1A and 1B.
