Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the State which pays the highest salary to the Anganwadi teachers in the country;
- (b) whether the Government is considering to provide equal salaries to all Anganwadi teachers at par with the highest paying State and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the share of the salary of these Anganwadi teachers contributed by the Union Government?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- a. Statement indicating the additional honorarium given by State/ UTs from their own resources to Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) and Anganwadi Helpers (AWHs) is placed at Annexure I.
- b. There is no proposal under consideration.
- c. The prescribed cost sharing ratio between Central and State Governments for the Honorarium given to Anganwadi workers and helpers is as under: States/ UTs with Legislature - 60:40

NE / Himalayan States (including J&K) - 90: 10

UT without legislature- 100:0

This is applicable to all States/UTs. Government releases funds to the States/UTs as per the prescribed cost sharing ratio
