MISSION SHAKTI IN RAJASTHAN

4011. COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE:

Will the Minister of Women and Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of data highlighting the achievements of Mission Shakti in Rajasthan especially in the rural areas;
- (b) the total number of Shakti Sadan homes built for widows/marginalised women/victims of trafficking in Rajasthan, especially the number built in the last nine years, along with the number of beneficiaries therein, district-wise;
- (c) the number of women who have benefited from the Sakhi Niwas (Working Women Hostels) scheme, State-wise and district-wise for Rajasthan;
- (d) the details of funds released and number of beneficiaries under the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) in Rajasthan during the last five years; and
- (e) the number of beneficiaries enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) during the last three years, district-wise for Rajasthan?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT
(SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a): The Government of India has launched 'Mission Shakti' – an integrated women empowerment programme as umbrella scheme for the safety, security and empowerment of women for implementation during the 15th Finance Commission period across the country including the State of Rajasthan. 'Mission Shakti' comprises of two sub-schemes 'Sambal' and 'Samarthya' for safety and security of women and empowerment of women respectively. The existing schemes of One Stop Centres (OSC), Women Helplines (181-WHL) and Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) have been made part of Sambal sub- scheme; while the existing schemes of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), Ujjwala, Swadhar Greh and Working Women Hostel and National Creche Scheme have been included in 'Samarthya'. A new component of Hub for Empowerment of Women has been included in 'Samarthya' sub-scheme, under which the Central Government provides financial assistance to States/ UTs for setting up of Hub at State and District level.

(b): As on date, total number of 9 Shakti Sadans (8 Swadhar Greh & 1 Ujjawala Home) operational covered 187 beneficiaries (157 through Swadhar Greh and 30 through Ujjawala Home) in the State of Rajasthan.

(c): District-wise details of number of women benefited from Sakhi Niwas (Working Women Hostel) in Rajasthan is at **Annexure-I**.

(d): The details of funds released and number of beneficiaries under the 'Scheme for Adolescent Girls(SAG) in the State of Rajasthan during last five years are as under:
