ADVERSE EVENTS FOLLOWING IMMUNIZATION (AEFI)

4051. SHRI KURUVA GORANTLA MADHAV:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the mechanism set-up to report COVID-19 vaccine-related Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI);
- (b) the State-wise number of AEFI cases reported from Government Hospitals and Private Hospitals including minor, severe, and serious cases and the number of AEFI related deaths;
- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to sensitize the common public and hospitals, in the private and government sector, regarding timely reporting of AEFI; and
- (d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to curb the under-reporting of AEFI related cases?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of COVID-19 vaccines are reported and monitored through a well-structured and robust AEFI surveillance system under the Universal Immunization Program.
 - For the reporting of COVID-19 vaccination related AEFIs, the SAFEVAC (a web based application for AEFI) is integrated into Co-WIN and reporting of AEFIs is done through the Co-WIN SAFEVAC. The Co-WIN SAFEVAC has the provision of reporting AEFIs by the vaccinator, district immunization officer and the beneficiary themselves.
- (b) State-wise number of AEFI cases including minor, severe, and serious cases and deaths reported is placed at **Annexure-I & II** respectively.

- 1) Information to sensitize public on Adverse events following COVID-19 vaccine and its reporting have been detailed in the COVID-19 Vaccination Operational Guidelines and COVID-19 Vaccines Communication Strategy and are available at MoHFW website.
- 2) Guidelines have been issued to States/UTs to direct district immunization officers to strengthen reporting of AEFIs following COVID-19 vaccination by networking with hospitals and medical colleges in the Private and Government sector. Covid vaccination program managers in the Government and private Covid Vaccination Centers (CVCs) including hospitals have also been oriented on it.
- 3) Information regarding reporting of AEFI is displayed prominently on the COWIN home page.
- 4) Vaccinators have been trained to inform beneficiaries visiting for vaccination on the likely benefits and risks associated with the COVID-19 vaccines as a part of four key messages provided to beneficiaries.
- 5) To enable reporting of adverse events, IEC material (posters) with information related to AEFI reporting have been shared with the States/UTs for translation into local language and display at the vaccination session sites.
- 6) Awareness on AEFI related information and messages are also amplified through social media and engagement of various immunization partners.
