(a) Yes Sir, Government has a proposal to adopt a maritime single window system as a part of the digitization initiative.

(b)&(c) National Logistics Portal (Marine) is being developed as a one stop digital platform where all maritime stakeholders are being integrated for easier and speedier services. Following are the features of the portal:

- a) Single Platform to perform all core activities of the Importer / Exporter / Customs Broker / Freight Forwarder.
- b) End-to-end functionality to perform online transaction with custodians.
- c) Providing a level playing field to relevant stakeholders.
- d) Complete domestic tracking of the shipment.
- e) Real time information of the activities.
- f) Enhanced transparency in Government to Business relations and Ease of doing Business.
- g) Document Management System to store all the important documents securely.
- h) Reduced costs and timeframes for execution of trade and logistics operations.
- i) Paper-less transaction, for all the stakeholders.
