ANGANWADI CENTRES IN ANDHRA PRADESH

4102. SHRIMATI VANGA GEETHA VISWANATH:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Anganwadi centres currently operational in Andhra Pradesh, districtwise;

(b) whether any steps have been taken to review the implementation of ICDS Scheme;(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the quantum of funds sanctioned and utilised for the Anganwadi centres in the State during the last three years?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) As informed by the State of Andhra Pradesh, number of Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) currently operational in the State, district-wise, is annexed.

(b) & (c) Under Anganwadi Services Scheme (Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0) there have been sustained engagements with State Governments/UT Administrations to review and improve AWCs which have included interactions to discuss different implementation related issues such as Anganwadi Infrastructure, operationalisation of non-operational AWCs, coverage of targetted beneficiaries etc. to strengthen the services under the scheme. Further streamlined guidelines were issued on 13.01.2021, covering several aspects such as quality assurance, roles and responsibilities of duty holders, procedure for procurement, integrating AYUSH concepts and data management and monitoring. Additionally, a robust ICT enabled platform named 'Poshan tracker' is in operation to capture real-time data on implementation and monitoring of AWCs across the country for transparency, efficiency and accountability in delivery of Supplementary Nutrition. The Poshan Tracker management application provides a 360 -degree view of the activities of the AWC, service deliveries of Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) and complete beneficiary management. As on 22.03.2023, 100035869 beneficiaries have been reported on Poshan Tracker of which 92% are Aadhaar verified and in the State of Andhra Pradesh 2781573 beneficiaries have been reported on Poshan Tracker of which 90% are Aadhaar verified.

Further as informed by the State of Andhra Pradesh, guidelines have been issued by the State Government constituting official monitoring and review committees to review implementation of the Scheme at various levels. Under the guidelines the State, District, Block and Anganwadi level Committees were constituted to monitor the regular functioning of AWCs and supervision visits to AWC by Anganwadi functionaries and suggest action to improve delivery of services at the AWCs.

(d) The quantum of funds sanctioned and utilized by the State of Andhra Pradesh during the last three years is as under:
