SALIENT FEATURES OF SAHITYOTSAV**

4215. SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently organized a literature festival 'Sahityotsav';
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the events organised in the said festival;
- (c) the salient features of the 'Sahityotsav' festival and the status of participation by various States;
- (d) the measures taken by the Government for encouraging participation in the literary field; and
- (e) whether such literary festivals are being organised on a regular basis in the country and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes sir. Literature festival 'Sahityotsav' was organized by the Sahitya Akademi, an autonomous body working under M/o Culture.
- (b) The festival was organized from 11 March to 16 March 2023 at Rabindra Bhawan, Firozeshah Road in New Delhi. The list of events organized in the said festival is annexed as annexure-I.
- (c) The salient features of the festival are as follows:
 - The theme of the festival was Indian Literature and Unity of Culture
 - More than 40 programmes were held
 - More than 400 writers, critics, poets, translators, publishers, diplomats, media personalities and eminent personalities from various walks of life participated.
 - 5-member Kazakh delegation participated in the festival under Indo-Kazak Cultural Exchange Programme
 - All the 24 Indian languages recognized by Sahitya Akademi were represented in the festival apart from the oral and tribal languages of India.
- (d) For encouraging participation in the literary field, the Government regularly organizes literary meets, zonal, national and international literature festivals, publish literary books, organize/participate in the book fairs and also accords awards to senior writers, young writers, translators, writers of children's books etc.
- (e) Yes sir, since 1985, Sahityotsav is organized annually by Sahitya Akademi. In addition, Government organizes literature festivals throughout the country at different occasions. For instance, in 2022, Unmesha, International Literature Festival, as a part of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav', was held in Shimla where more than 400 national and international writers/literature experts had participated.
