Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether various programmes and felicitation celebrations are organized by Government on the days related to the Janm Gyaan and Mahaparinirvana of Lord Gautam Buddha in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of functions organized on these days across the country during the last five years;
- (c) whether the work of disseminating the teachings of Lord Buddha to the people is done through these functions and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the foreign dignitaries and guests are also participating across the world in these functions and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the other steps being taken by the Government to popularize and disseminate the teachings of Gautam Buddha in the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a) Yes, Sir. The Janm, Gyaan & Mahaparinirvan day also known as 'Triple Vaishakh Day' (Buddha Poornima) is celebrated by the Government through various programmes and felicitation celebrations.
- (b) Details of functions organized by Government on the days related to the Janm, Gyaan and Mahaparinirvana of Lord Gautam Buddha during the last five years are given as under:

- (c) Yes, Sir. The events are attended by large number of monastics and lay persons from India and abroad. The events are also telecasted live through digital platform for wider dissemination.
- (d) Yes, Sir. The participation of monastics from other countries of the world is ensured through respective Embassies located in various countries.

To provide education in Buddhist/Tibetan philosophies and Culture & Art through the system of a modern university, the following four Autonomous Organizations are working under the administrative control of Ministry of Culture, Government of India:

- i. Nava Nalanda Mahavihara, Nalanda, Bihar (Deemed To Be University)
- **ii.** Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies (CIHTS), Sarnath (Deemed To Be University)
- iii. Central Institute of Himalayan Culture Studies (CIHCS), Dahung , Arunachal Pradesh

2. In addition to the aforesaid four Autonomous Organizations, Ministry of Culture also provides annual grants-in-aid for the upkeep and maintenance of the following six Grantee Bodies for promoting Buddhist/Tibetan Culture and Art:

- i. Library of Tibetan Works and Archives, Dharamshala
- ii Tibet House, New Delhi
- iii Centre for Buddhist Cultural Studies, Tawang Monastery, Arunachal Pradesh
- iiii Namgyal Institute of Tibetology, Sikkim
- iiv International Buddhist Confederation
- iv GRL Monastic School, Bomdila, Arunachal Pradesh
