NABARD SCHEME FOR TRIBALS

4266. MS. DEBASREE CHAUDHURI:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) is implementing any scheme for the welfare of tribal people across the country;
- (b) if so, the details with regard to the State of West Bengal during the last five years and the current financial year;
- (c) the details of the funds allocated and the benefits availed by the tribal people under the said schemes/programmes in West Bengal during the said period, district-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken by NABARD to provide assistance to the backward tribal communities of the country?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (DR. BHAGWAT KARAD)

- (a) Yes, NABARD has been implementing Integrated Tribal Development Programme since 2005-06, under which, projects are funded through Tribal Development Fund (TDF), aiming to provide sustainable livelihoods to tribal families of the country.
- (b) In West Bengal, NABARD has sanctioned a total of 18 Tribal Development Projects during the last five years and current financial year. The projects are implemented through participatory approach involving project beneficiaries and NGO partners. The summary of details given in *Annexure-I* is as under:
 - 2017-18: 05 projects
 - 2018-19: 03 projects
 - 2019-20: 04 projects
 - 2020-21: 02 projects
 - 2021-22: 02 projects
 - 2022-23: 02 projects (as on 16.03.2023)
- (c) The details of funds sanctioned under the TDF during the said period in West Bengal and the district-wise details of the benefits availed by the tribal people under the said programme are given in *Annexure-II*.

TDF projects implemented by NABARD are through orchard-based approach and other livelihood-based activities and the benefits start accruing to the families/project beneficiaries after 4-5 years. Generally, increase in annual household income, increase in the irrigation facility, diversification of crop, improved access to latest farm technology, increase in ownership of assets, etc., are some benefits which are observed in the TDF projects.

(d) NABARD created a dedicated fund *viz.*, Tribal Development Fund, in the year 2003-04, out of its own profits for providing support to tribal families of India for generating sustainable livelihood opportunities. The first project from TDF was sanctioned in the year 2005-06 and since then, 929 projects have been sanctioned by NABARD, benefitting 5.95 lakh families covering an area of 5.61 lakh acres. Grant support is provided for developing small orchard (called wadi), agri-allied activities, microenterprise development, tribal handicraft promotion activities, etc. In addition to this, support is provided for promoting awareness about health and sanitation, women development activities and providing training and capacity building to the project beneficiaries.
