NEW SCHEME ROLLED OUT

†4289. SHRI JASWANT SINGH BHABHOR:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the new schemes rolled out by the Government in the country and the quantum of financial allocation made for these schemes;
- (b) the details of the works undertaken in Gujarat district-wise especially in Dahod under the said schemes; and
- (c) the details of such works undertaken during the last three years location and Statewise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SMT. RENUKA SINGH SARUTA)

- (a) to (c): Ministry of Tribal Affairs has revamped the earlier Scheme of 'Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) with nomenclature 'Pradhan Mantri Adi Adarsh Gram Yojna(PMAAGY)', for implementation during 2021-22 to 2025-26, which aims at integrated development of villages with significant tribal population covering about population of 4.22 crore (About 40% of the total Tribal Population). It is envisaged to cover 36,428 villages having at least 50% tribal population and 500 STs across States / UTs with notified STs. The main objective of this scheme is to achieve integrated socio-economic development of selected villages through convergence approach. It includes the following components.
 - i. Preparing Village Development Plan based on the needs, potential, and aspirations;
 - ii. Maximizing the coverage of individual / family benefit schemes of the Central / State Governments;
- iii. Improving the infrastructure in vital sectors like health, education, connectivity and livelihood;

The scheme envisions to mitigate gaps prominently in 8 sectors of development viz. Road connectivity (Internal and Inter village /block), Telecom connectivity (Mobile /internet), School, Anganwadi Centres, Health Sub-Centre, Drinking water facility, Drainage and solid waste management. A sum of ₹20.38 lakh per village as 'Gap-filling' has been provisioned

for approved activities including administrative expenses under PMAAGY. Besides States / UTs are encouraged for convergence of resources as Central / State Scheduled Tribe Component (STC) funds and other financial resources available with them for saturation of gaps in the villages identified under PMAAGY.

During 2021-22 and 2022-23, a total of about 16554 villages have been taken up. So far, an amount of Rs. 2077.40 Crore has already been released to the States under the scheme. As far as Gujarat State is concerned, a total of 3764 villages have been identified under PMAAGY. Out of which village development plan for 1562 Villages (including 502 villages in Dahod district) have been approved and a total of Rs. 35318.54 lakh has been released to the State of Gujarat under the scheme. The details of the Village Development Plans (VDP) approved in Gujarat for the year 2021-22 under PMAAGY is at **Annexure 1**. The State-wise details of total villages identified under PMAAGY, No. of villages taken up during 2021-22 and 2022-23 and funds released as on 20.03.2023 is at **Annexure 2**.

Other then the Centrally Sponsored Scheme mentioned above, Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Vikas Mission, which seeks to achieve livelihood driven tribal development in the next five years through formation of Vandhan groups who have been organized into Vandhan Kendras. The MFP gathered by tribals will be processed in these kendras and marketed through Van Dhan Producer Enterprises. New haats bazaar and ware houses will be developed in next 5 years. TRIFED would be the nodal agency for implementing the scheme. The products produced will be marketed through Tribe India Stores. An amount of Rs. 1612 cr has been earmarked under the Mission for next five years. Existing Livelihood schemes Marketing of Minor Forest Produce (MFP) through Minimum Support Price (MSP) and Development of Value Chain for MFP' (MSP for MFP) and Institutional support for development and marketing of Tribal Products and Produce have been revamped with several new components to form PMJVM.
