Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:-

- (a) the date on which Pradhan Mantri Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana was launched by the Government for safe future of girls in the country along with the details thereof;
- (b) whether there is any laid down criteria for the selection of beneficiaries of the said scheme and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the number of eligible girls benefited from the said scheme since December, 2022, State/UT-wise and year-wise; and
- (d) the district-wise details of the girls benefitted and the amount provided to them under the said scheme in the State of Rajasthan during each of the last four years?

- (a) Sukanya Samriddhi Account (SSA) Scheme was notified by Government vide Gazette Notification G.S.R. No.863(E) dated 02.12.2014 and launched formally on 22.01.2015.
- (b) SSA is a deposit Scheme and an account under this Scheme may be opened by one of the guardian in the name of a girl child, who has not attained the age of ten years as on the date of opening of the account.
- (c) Month-wise and State/UT-wise details of outstanding number of accounts opened under SSA since December, 2022 to February, 2023 is attached as 'Annexure-1'.
- (d) SSA is deposit scheme wherein the account holder makes deposit as per the provision of the Scheme. The district-wise details of outstanding number of accounts and outstanding balance under SSA in the State of Rajasthan during last four years is attached as 'Annexure-2'.
