- (a) the quantum of funds spent to renovate temples in India year-wise from 2004 till now;
- (b) whether the Ministry has similar programmes for renovating Churches, Mosques and other important places of worship; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The Archaeological Survey of India takes care of 3696 Centrally Protected Monuments in various parts of country including 1081 temples. The quantum of funds spent on the CPMs including temples in India year-wise from 2004 till now is being complied. Funds spent since 2018 till date is placed at Annexure -I
- (b) Archaeological Survey of India undertakes conservation works of all CPMs including & Temples, Churches, Mosques and other important places of worship, as and when
- (c) necessary. The conservation and preservation of CPMs is a continuous process. Conservation works are carried out by ASI every year as per requirement and availability of resources.
