IRREGULARITIES UNDER PMAY-G

4382. SHRI JAGDAMBIKA PAL:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of the beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) during the year 2020-21 and 2021-22, State and district-wise particularly in Uttar Pradesh and North Eastern States;
- (b) the details of the houses allotted, State and district-wise particularly in Uttar Pradesh and Meghalaya;
- (c) whether the Government is planning to increase the number of beneficiaries under PMAY-G, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government is targeting to provide houses for all in rural area and if so, the time by which this target will get achieved and the amount that has been sanctioned by the Government in the year 2022 for the scheme; and
- (e) whether irregularities have been identified in the implementation of the PMAY-G and if so, the details of the action taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b) The State/ Union Territory (UT) - wise number of houses sanctioned to the beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) during 2020-21 and 2021-22, particularly in Uttar Pradesh and North-Eastern States including Meghalaya is given in **Annexure**.

The district-wise details of houses sanctioned can be seen at the programme website at www.pmayg.nic.in--->AwaasSoft--->Reports--->Houses progress against the target financial year.

(c) & (d) The Union Cabinet had approved the overall target of construction of 2.95 crore houses by March, 2024, against which a total of 2.86 crore houses have been sanctioned and 2.22 crore houses have been completed as on 22.03.2023. At present, there is no proposal for enhancing the coverage and extending the target date for completion of targeted houses. So far, the Government had allocated Rs. 30,057.15 crore for FY 2021-22 and Rs. 48,422 crore for FY 2022-23 for implementation of the scheme.

(e) Under PMAY-G, there is a grievance redressal mechanism set up at different levels of administration viz., Gram Panchayat, Block, District and the State. The cases of irregularities reported by the Hon'ble Members of Parliament, Members of State Assembly and general public directly or through CPGRAMS are taken up with the State Government for taking necessary action. Since inception of PMAY-G i.e. 01.04.2016 till 23.03.2023, a total of 1,787 complaints relating to irregularities in implementation of PMAY-G have been received in the Ministry of Rural Development on CPGRAMS. As the State Govt. implements PMAY-G, these complaints have been forwarded to the State for taking necessary action under intimation to this Ministry. Out of 1,787 complaints, 1,757 have been disposed of as on 23.03.2023.
