IMPLEMENTATION OF DAY-NRLM

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana–National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM);
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated, released and utilized under this mission during each of the last three years and the current year, Statewise, particularly in Rajasthan and Assam;
- (c) the details of the target set and achievements made so far along with its response for each subscheme and programme under the mission, Statewise including Rajasthan and Assam;
- (d) whether the Government is proposing to support the products made by Self Help Groups of the said mission across the country;
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the steps being taken by the Government in this regard;
- (f) the details of the Rural Self Employment Institutes (RSETIs) set up for skilling rural youth along with the number of beneficiaries particularly in Rajasthan;
- (g) the details and success of National Rural Economic Transformation Project under the Mission; and
- (h) the number of Centres for Financial Literacy and Service Delivery (SAKSHAM Centres) set up under the Mission in Rajasthan along with number of beneficiaries, district-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT
(SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) The Ministry is implementing Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY – NRLM) across the country (except Delhi & Chandigarh) with the objective of organizing the rural poor women into Self Help Groups (SHGs) and continuously nurturing and supporting them till they attain appreciable increase in incomes over a period of time and improve their quality of life and come out of abject poverty. As on 28th February 2023, the Mission has already mobilized approximately 8.93 crore women from rural households into 82.61 Lakh SHGs.

The salient features of the DAY-NRLM are:

- i. Promotion of Sustainable Institutions of the poor
- ii. Ensuring access to financial services
- iii. Promote diversified livelihoods opportunities for the poor, in farm and non-farm sectors.
- iv. Promotion of Skill Development and access to Jobs
- v. Promotion of Social Inclusion and Human Development

(b) & (c) The sub-schemes under DAY-NRLM are (i) National Rural Economic Transformation Project (NRETP); (ii) Mahila Kisan Sashaktikaran Pariyojana (MKSP); (iii) Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP); (iv) Deendayal Upadhyay Gramin Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY); and (v) Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETI). The details of the funds sanctioned/ allocated/, and released / utilized under DAY-NRLM and its sub-schemes during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise, including Rajasthan and Assam is given in **Annexure-I** and the targets and achievements so far under them, State/UT wise, including in Rajasthan and Assam, are given in **Annexure-II**.

(d) & (e) Yes Sir, the Ministry is organising SARAS Aajeevika Mela at National level & State/UTs are also organising SARAS Aajeevika Mela at state/district level which aims at facilitating and motivating Self Help Groups (SHGs)/SHG Members under DAY-NRLM to exhibit and sell their products and to provide them with an opportunity for additional income, exposure and interaction on a large scale. Further, for exhibition and sale of SHG products, the Ministry has setup a store 'SARAS Gallery' at New Delhi & some States are also having stores for exhibition & sale of SHG products.

In addition, the Ministry, in collaboration with Government e-Marketplace (GeM) has created "SARAS Collection" as a store front on GeM platform for marketing of SHG products. Also, Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs) have been entered between this Ministry and Flipkart Internet Pvt. Ltd. & Amazon respectively to allow the Self Help Groups (SHGs) producers, including the artisans, weavers and craftsmen to access national markets through the Flipkart Samarth programme and Amazon Saheli initiative. An MoU has also been signed by the Ministry with Patanjali for collaboration in various fields including online marketing of SHGs products. An e-Commerce platform (www.esaras.in) has also been launched by the Ministry for online marketing of SHG products. Recently, an MoU has been signed between MoRD and Fashnear Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (Meesho) on February 16, 2023 for onboarding and marketing of SHGs products. Some states have also developed their own e-Commerce platform to support marketing of products of SHGs.

(f) 590 RSETIs, promoted by Banks, are functioning across the country extending skill and entrepreneurship development training programmes to rural poor un-employed youth to facilitate them to employ themselves by taking up self-employment units/activities. Since inception, a total of 44.42 lakhs youths have been trained and 31.54 lakhs youths have been settled up-to 28th February, 2023. In state of Rajasthan a total of 2.5 lakh youths have been trained and 1.85 lakh youths have been settled as on 28th February, 2023.

(g) National Rural Economic Transformation Project (NRETP) is being implemented in 13 high poverty States namely Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal and Assam to pilot higher level activities like new/alternative ways of financial inclusion and delivery of

financial services in rural areas, diversified and higher-level livelihoods interventions, effective marketing of SHG products through value chain development, strengthening of cluster level federations, innovative methods of skills training and placement support etc.
