MGNREGS IN MAHARASHTRA

SHRI RAMDAS C. TADAS:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) is being implemented in the State of Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under MGNREGS during each of the last three years and the current year, State and district-wise particularly Wardha Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra;
- (c) the status of compliance of set instructions regarding the work place of MGNREGS in Maharashtra;
- (d) whether there are such MGNREGS labourers in Maharashtra who have not been provided 100 days of employment and if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (e) the status of the payment of MGNREGS workers in Maharashtra;
- (f) whether the Government has identified the works which can be executed through MGNREGS along with the construction work done in Maharashtra since last five financial years;
- (g) if so, the details thereof, district-wise particularly in Wardha Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra along with the estimated amount for this work; and
- (h) the details of the targets fixed in this regard and the time by which it is likely to be started?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme. There is no State/UT-wise allocation of funds under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS. Also, there is no district-wise release of funds under the Scheme.

State/UT wise release of funds under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS during last three financial years 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and current financial year 2022-23 (as on 24.03.2023) is given at **Annexure-I.**

(c) As per the information shared by the State Government of Maharashtra, all instructions are being followed in work places of Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in Maharashtra.

(d) Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is a demand driven wage employment Scheme which provides for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work. It provides livelihood security, i.e. fall back options for livelihood for the rural households, when no better employment opportunity is available.

As per the information shared by the State Government of Maharashtra, District-wise number of households completed 100 days of employment under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in the State of Maharashtra in financial year 2022-23 (as on 23.03.2023) is given at **Annexure-II**.

(e) In the financial year 2022-23 (as on 25.03.2023), 90.13 % Fund Transfer Orders (FTOs) are generated within 15 days from the closure of muster rolls in the State of Maharashtra under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS.

(f) to (h) Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is a demand driven wage employment scheme **with bottom up planning**. The works are identified, approved and prioritized out of shelf of work by the Gram Panchayat, recommended by Gram Sabha in each State/UT as per the provision of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act. Accordingly, the works are approved and taken up by Panchayat as per the demand. The planning of works is done as per the estimated person days to be generated for the work in a financial year at the time of assessment of Labour Budget. **The Ministry does not provide any target or plan for any kind of work to be taken up at the Gram Panchayat level.**

As per Section 29 of the Act, Central Government may add new works to the permissible list of works under Schedule 1 of the Act. Adding new works under Schedule 1 of the Act is a regular exercise and new works are added on the basis of merit in alignment with the focus and objectives of the Act. Accordingly, there are 266 permissible works under Mahatma Gandhi NREG Act.

District wise details of the works completed and expenditures incurred in the State of Maharashtra under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS during the last five financial years are given at **Annexure-III**.
