Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state;

- (a) whether the National Statistical Commission (NSO) has conducted any survey to find out the total area of agriculture production under leased lands in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise particularly in Maharashtra and Odisha;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that the tenant farmers operating on such lands are excluded from DBT schemes including PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (d) weather the Government propose to consider any assistance or subsides to support tenant farmers in the country;
- (e) if so, the details in this regard along with the manner in which the Government proposes to assist such farmers to respect their contribution to agriculture sector;
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (g) the time by which the final decision is likely to be taken in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): As per Situation Assessment of Agricultural Households and Land and Holdings of Households in Rural India, 2019, NSS 77th Round (January-December, 2019) conducted by National Statistical Office (NSO), the details of distribution of leased in land and operated by households (only for agricultural use) in the country and State-wise including Maharashtra and Odisha is given at **Annexure.**

- (c): The Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) Scheme is a Central Sector Scheme. PM-KISAN provides an income support of Rs. 6000/- per year in 3 equal instalments to all farmers families who own cultivable landholding irrespective of the size of the landholding, subject to certain exclusion criteria. Ownership of a cultivable landholding remains the basic criteria to avail the benefit under the Scheme.
- (d) to (g): The Modified Interest Subvention Scheme was launched in the year 2006-07 with a view to provide short term Agri-loans availed by farmers through KCC for their working capital requirements at a concessional rate of interest. Under the scheme, farmers who are owner cultivators-both individual/joint borrowers; tenant farmers, oral lessees and share croppers; Self Help Groups or Joint Liability Groups of farmers including tenant farmers etc., are given KCC loan at subvented interest rate of 7%. Additional 3% subvention is also given to the farmers for prompt and timely repayment of loans; thus reducing the effective rate of interest to 4% per annum.
