(a) to (e) Details of Steps taken to strengthen the Public health systemand related infrastructure in the country are at Annexure. 117 CGHS Wellness Centres are functioning in rented buildings (91 Private Buildings and 26 Government Buildings) across the country.

Government considers opening of new WC as per extant norms, which include minimum 6000 Central Government Serving employees in the city, subject to availability of resources, sanction for creation of posts of Medical Officers, Staff Nurse, Pharmacists, and Clerical Staff etc. by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, and availability of suitable accommodation for new Wellness Centres.
