Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of creation of National Statistical Business Register, in accordance with the Government's earlier proposal of conducting 7th Economic Census;
- (b) if so, the details of the extent to which it is likely to help in new employment generation; and
- (c) the special emphasis taken/being taken by the National Statistical Commission, on ensuring collection of unbiased data, which likely to be assist in respect of policy-making, coordination and certification of quality of Core Statistics, during the past three years and the current year?

(a) & (b): The development of National Statistical Business Register is envisaged as a follow up activity of 7th Economic Census. Economic Census aims to provide a framework for the development of National Statistical Business Register. Statistical Business Register may be

leveraged for designing developmental policies for economic growth, employment generation, etc.

(c): National Statistical Commission has emphasized on improving quality of survey data collection by rationalization of schedules to reduce respondent burden; adopting technological intervention to modernize survey set up; modification in survey methodology and restructuring/regrouping of survey schedules for reducing time lag in releasing survey reports, etc.
