 - (ii) Raw Material Supply Scheme(RMSS)

Under these schemes, financial assistance is provided to the eligible handloom agencies/ weavers for raw materials, upgraded looms & accessories, infrastructure development, design & product development, marketing of handloom products in domestic/overseas markets, weavers MUDRA loans etc.
