(a) whether the Government is aware that Telecom companies have invested heavily in building crosscountry cables but there is a significantly lower development of infrastructure that connects the major cities across States; and

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the Government's reaction thereto?

(a) & (b) Government as well as Telecom companies have laid optical fibre cable not only for cross country but also to strengthen urban and remote area connectivity. Major cities and towns across the States/ UTs are adequately connected. BharatNet Project is implemented in phase manner to provide fibre connectivity to all Gram Panchayats (GPs) in the country. The scope of BharatNet project has been extended up to all inhabited villages beyond GPs in the country.
