- (a) whether the Government proposes to provide free foodgrains to all the 81 crore beneficiaries covered under the National Food Security Act (NFSA) for one more year; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise along with the beneficiary families, criteria being adopted and budgetary allocations made in this regard as on date?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): The Central Government to remove the financial burden of the poor beneficiaries and to ensure nationwide uniformity and effective implementation of the Act, has decided to provide food grains free of cost to Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households and Priority Households (PHH) beneficiaries under National Food Security Act, for a period of one year beginning from 1st January 2023. Budgetary Allocations for 2022-23 is Rs. 2,86,978.50 crore. No State-wise and district-wise separate allocation of funds is made by Government of India. A statement indicating the State/Union Territory wise beneficiaries covered under NFSAis at Annexure.
