## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR TRADITIONAL FABRICS MANUFACTURING

## 4722. SHRI VIVEK NARAYAN SHEJWALKAR:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Government has received any proposal from the Government of Madhya Pradesh regarding setting up of Textile Park;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the details of financial assistance being provided by the Government for traditional fabrics manufacturing?

## उत्तर ANSWER वस्त्र राज्य मंत्री (**श्रीमती दर्शना जरदोश**) THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES (SMT. DARSHANA JARDOSH)

(a) & (b): The Government has approved setting up of 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of Rs. 4,445 crore for a period of seven years upto 2027-28. All states were requested to send proposals to the Ministry under the Scheme. Against the 4 proposals received from the State Government of Madhya Pradesh for setting up of PM MITRA Parks at (i) Ratlam, (ii) Devas, (iii) Dhar & (iv) Katni, the Government has finalised the site of Dhar in Madhya Pradesh for setting of PM MITRA Park.

(c): The Government is implementing National Handloom Development Programme (NHDP) and Raw Material Supply Scheme for development and production of handloom sector and welfare of handloom weavers across the country. Under these schemes, financial assistance is provided to the eligible handloom agencies/weavers for raw material, common infrastructure development, marketing of handloom product in domestic/ overseas market, Weavers Mudra Loan etc. In addition, incentives to the textile industry are also extended through other schemes including Production Linked Incentive Scheme.

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
