**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government is aware that majority of population of Saurashtrians resides within the vicinity of Borivali and Malad Stations and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether any representations have been received requesting for stoppage of train no. 12267/68 Mumbai Central-Hapa Duronto Express at Borivali or Malad;**
- (c) if so, the details and the action taken thereon; and**
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor and the time by which it is likely to be taken?**

**(a) to (d) Representations, including from the Hon'ble Member of Parliament, have been received for provision of stoppage of 12267/68 Mumbai Central-Hapa Duronto Express at Borivali station. 12267/68 Mumbai Central-Hapa Duronto Express is a fast service with limited stoppages enroute. Proliferation of stoppages enroute the said train is operationally not expedient, at present. However, provision of stoppages, which depends on operational feasibility and commercial justification, is an ongoing process on Indian Railways.**
